

2014 Senior Group Tour Schedule

After several meetings with our energetic tour committee members and in consideration of several suggestions offered by members, we wish to present the following tours for our travel schedule for 2014! Our hope is that everyone will support this program as well as it was supported in 2013. Deluxe transportation and an escort are included on all tours.

February 27, Thursday – Delaware Park Casino – Departing York at 9am and returning by 6pm this tour includes \$30 in free slot play for \$40 per person.

March 26, Wednesday – Mount Airy Casino and Resort includes a Luncheon Buffet, \$25 in free slot play and the premier multimedia Beatles show in America, “*Beatlemania Now*” for \$95 per person.

April 24, Thursday – Antietam National Battlefield plus the Chesapeake & Ohio Canal includes a Battlefield Tour with Guide plus time in the Museum and Gift Shop, Boxed Lunch, Boat Ride on the C&O Canal, view of the Great Falls, Dinner Buffet in Gettysburg en route home for \$105 per person.

April 26-27, Saturday & Sunday – Spring Winery Tour to the Finger Lakes where everyone will have the opportunity to visit approximately 14 wineries, sample several wines at each and enjoy food samplings. Favorite wines may also be purchased and stored under the motor coach to be brought home. This has become a wonderful time for friends and families to enjoy the Springtime, relax and take in the beauty of the Finger Lakes. *Price to be announced.*

May 1, Thursday – Frank Lloyd Wright Homes, Fallingwater and Kentuck Knob near Pittsburgh includes tours of both homes and dinner buffet at the Oakhurst Tea Room for \$142 per person.

May 14, Wednesday – “Back Roads of Lancaster County” visiting off the road Amish shops and stores including lunch in an Amish home with local guide, Edie for \$98 per person.

May 19-23, Monday to Friday – Cape Cod, Boston and Plymouth including Hyannis, Provincetown and Sandwich, Massachusetts. This tour includes 4 nights lodging, luggage handling, Welcome Reception, Guided tour of Cape Cod to Provincetown along Historic Rt. 6A, Dune tour or Whale Watch, Guided tours of Boston, Plymouth, Hyannis and Sandwich with the Sandwich Glass Museum, 4 breakfasts and 4 dinners including one Lobster Dinner, meal and lodging taxes, meal gratuities and Escort for \$639 per person double occupancy.

Deposit for this trip is \$75 per person.

June 19, Thursday - Delaware Park Race Track and Casino – Departing York at 9am and returning by 6pm this tour includes \$30 in free slot play for \$40 per person.

June 25, Wednesday – **New York City Food Shopping Tour** with expert guide includes shopping stops at famous local markets including Zabars, Eataly, Chelsea Market, Chinatown, Little Italy and Union Square Outdoor Food Markets. Yes, we'll make our famous dinner stop at Mastoris (on your own) for everyone's dining enjoyment en route home for \$125 per person

July 26-27, Saturday and Sunday – **Cooperstown National Baseball Hall of Fame Induction**. This year's Hall of Fame class should include some very famous and recognizable names including Braves Greg Maddox, Tom Glavine, Bobby Cox, and Yankees Joe Torre and Mike Mussina. We're experts on this tour having been there for 15 years and include admission to the National Baseball Hall of Fame, Sunday's Hall of Fame Ceremonies and Induction, one night lodging, one breakfast and lots of insider information for \$242 per person sharing a room.

August 21, Thursday - **Delaware Park Race Track and Casino** – Departing York at 9am and returning by 6pm this tour includes \$30 in free slot play for \$40 per person.

September 3, Wednesday – **Valley Forge National Historic Park and Eastern State Penitentiary** includes visits to two famous sights that once welcomed General George Washington and Gangster Al Capone. We will enjoy a guided tour of the famous site of Washington's encampment at Valley Forge followed by lunch on-your-own at Philadelphia's famous Reading Terminal Market. Touring at the Eastern State Penitentiary known as the "prisons, prison" was a state of the art facility and the most expensive prison built in the world. Other prisons were built using this original design. Chicago gangster, Al Capone's cell is highlighted. All for \$98 per person.

September 13, Saturday – **Harpers Ferry and Gettysburg National Historic Parks** includes Ranger guided walking tour and time to explore beautiful and historic Harpers Ferry with a provide boxed lunch in town; admission to the new Gettysburg National Military Park Visitors center including the film, "New Birth of Freedom," the new Cyclorama depicting Pickett's Charge and the Museum of Civil War artifacts, interactive exhibits and multi-media presentations and Buffet dinner to end the day for \$115 per person.

September 17, Wednesday – **Mystery Dine Around Tour** to an Out-of-State location featuring touring and four courses for everyone’s entertaining and dining enjoyment!! \$112 per person.

September 18-26, Thursday to Friday – **9 Day Canada and New England Cruise with Royal Caribbean’s Grandeur of the Sea from Baltimore.** Ports of Call include Portland and Bar Harbor, Maine; Saint John, New Brunswick and Halifax, Nova Scotia. Inside cabin starting at \$879 per person; Ocean View cabin at \$1,209 per person (Balcony cabin, call for prices). Prices will increase as inventory decreases. Government taxes & fees are additional. \$250 per person deposit is required to confirm a reservation and is refundable until July 4, 2014.

September 19-21, Friday to Sunday – **Trains of West Virginia** includes rides on both the New Tygart Flyer with lunch and the Durbin Rocket out of Elkins, WV. Riding the “Hills” of West Virginia will be our first real experience as we find time to stop and tour the National Radio Astronomy Observatory. American Mountain Theater showing of “The History of American Music,” two nights lodging, two breakfasts, two dinners and one lunch are also featured for \$485 per person, double occupancy.

September 29 to October 6, Friday to Monday - **Nashville, Memphis and Branson and Pigeon Forge.** This premium “Southern Show Tour” is LOADED with food and entertainment including 7 live music shows, 3 more dinner shows, (14 total meals + 1 ice cream social), 7 nights lodging, Country Music Hall of Fame, Grand Old Opry, Graceland, Sun Studios Tour, Ryman Auditorium for \$1,450 double occupancy.

October 2, Thursday - **Delaware Park Race Track and Casino** – Departing York at 9am and returning by 6pm this tour includes \$30 in free slot play for \$40 per person.

October 16-17, Thursday & Friday – **Richmond, Virginia and the Civil War** includes the American Civil War Center, Richmond National Battlefield Park Visitors Center, Museum of the Confederacy, Civil War Medical Museum, Virginia State Capitol, Battlefield tour, 1 nights lodging, 1 breakfast and 1 dinner for \$289 per person.

October 21-22, Tuesday and Wednesday – **Skyline Drive Fall Foliage with President’s Homes** includes a beautiful, scenic Fall foliage drive over the Skyline Drive, a National Scenic Byway; one night lodging, admission to the homes of Presidents Thomas Jefferson’s, Monticello and James Monroe’s, Ash Lawn Highland, one breakfast, one lunch and two dinners for \$349 per person double occupancy.

October 23, Thursday – **Penn’s Peak Dinner Theater featuring “Bill Haley’s Comets”** This fine Rock’n’Roll group from the 1950’s is still together and going strong! November 12, Wednesday – **Radio City Music Hall’s Christmas Show** featuring the Rockettes in NYC. Time for shopping and exploring in the Times Square area. Yes, a fine dinner on-your-own will be featured at Mastoris on the way home. The price for this trip is \$170 per person. Deposit for this trip is \$70 per person.

November 30, Sunday – **Ford’s Theatre & Illumination Tour** featuring the matinee showing of the most well known of Christmas plays, “A Christmas Carol.” Historic Ford’s Theatre will be our initial destination included the newly renovated Museum and Peterson House where President Lincoln died. Our finale of the day will include a “Lights Tour” in Columbia, MD en route home for \$125 per person. Deposit for this trip is \$46 per person.

December 2, Tuesday – **ICE at the Gaylord National Resort, White House or DC Sightseeing** includes a visit to the now famous, Gaylord National Resort with its winter wonderland of 5,000 blocks of ice hand-sculptured by 40 International Artisans. We will also apply for a White House tour and plan on visiting the newly renovated, White House Visitors Center. If our application for the White House tour is not accepted a four hour professionally guided tour of the city and its monuments will be substituted. \$109 per person.

December 6, Saturday – **Radio City Music Hall’s Christmas Show** featuring the Rockettes in NYC. Time for shopping and exploring in the Times Square area. Yes, a fine dinner on-your-own will be featured at Mastoris on the way home. The price for this trip is \$220 per person. Deposit for this trip is \$125 per person.

December 7-8, Sunday and Monday – **“The Grand Illumination” in Williamsburg, Virginia** includes the “Grand Celebration” welcoming the Christmas Season in Colonial Williamsburg. Musical groups performing on three stages, fantastic fireworks, strolling minstrels, fireside vendors highlight this annual celebration. We’ll enjoy lunch in a Colonial Tavern and a walking tour of the Colonial town, a buffet dinner, one night lodging, one hotel breakfast and your choice of Monday Christmas shopping at the huge Prime Outlet Mall or continued touring in Colonial Williamsburg. All this for \$289 per person double occupancy.

December 9, Tuesday – **“The Diamonds” at Mt. Airy Casino and Resort** features this great 1950’s group in concert entitled, “Silver Bells.” The tour will also include a luncheon buffet and \$25 in free slot play for \$96.

December 18, Thursday - **American Music Theater Christmas Show** in Lancaster includes luncheon buffet at the Shady Maple Smorgasbord and the annual Christmas show at American Music Theater for \$92 per person.

Interior cabin priced at \$779; Ocean view Cabin at \$899 (Balcony cabin, call for prices). This is a group price that will rise as the ship’s inventory is being filled. Government taxes & fees are additional. \$450 per person deposit is required to confirm a reservation and is refundable until November 19, 2014.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

CANCELLATIONS: On all overnight trips & on any day trip that requires ticket pre-purchase, ticket prices are not refundable, unless the initial party can supply a replacement passenger. Please notify Krouse Travel (717-244-6410) immediately of any change and supply the name, etc. of the secured replacement. If a cancellation is made and a replacement is not secured, the maximum refund attainable will be returned. This rule is to protect the operation of each tour. Trip insurance is highly recommended for all trips. Pre-existing health conditions can be covered if purchased within 7 days of registration of each tour.

RESERVATIONS: All reservations must be accompanied with the listed deposit or final payment. Please pay by check made payable to **Krouse Travel**. Please list the trip name on the check. When paying for multiple trips with one check, show the monetary breakdown for each trip. **Mail payments to Krouse Travel, 20 Hampton Court, Red Lion, PA 17356**

DEPOSITS AND FINAL PAYMENT: All deposits for motorcoach tours are due at the time of reservation or within 10 days of making a reservation over the phone. Final payments are due no later than 60 days prior to departure. Unless otherwise indicated, please use the following chart for determining deposit amounts:

Tour cost \$50 or less = Full payment due at the time of reservation
Tour cost \$51-\$150 = \$25 per person deposit
Tour cost \$151-\$500 = \$50 per person deposit
Tour cost \$501 or more = \$100 per person deposit

EXECUTIVE DIRECTIVE: If you have any physical condition (walking, etc.) which requires continuous assistance, you are responsible to have a traveling companion who will assist and accompany you at all times and all places.

COST: The price of all Motor Coach tours include transportation, admissions and the amenities listed in each tour description. To operate most trips a minimum of 30 paying guests are need to be enrolled and paid within 30 days of departure. **Friends may be invited who are not members!**

BOARDING AREA & TIMES: Our boarding area is the Stony Brook (Food Lion Store) parking area at 3613 East Market Street, York, PA. Please park in the outer corner of the lot closest to the Roadhouse Restaurant. The area has 24 hour lighting. The individual Senior Clubs, Krouse Travel, transportation companies nor the parking lot owners and management will be liable for passenger or vehicle safety at any boarding area. On **all tours** an itinerary outlining the projected times, lodging venues and pertinent information will be mailed approximately two weeks prior to the trip’s departure. Of course we cannot account for delays caused by traffic or other problems that may be encountered. **PLEASE ARRIVE AT THE BOARDING AREA AT LEAST 10 MINUTES BEFORE DEPARTURE.**
